Ir Stephen Lau, JP

Secretary General (Honorary), Hong Kong Computer Society

Ir Stephen KM Lau, JP, Distinguished Fellow of the Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS), has over 30 years' experience in information technology and banking industries in both the government and private sector where he held a number of senior management positions, including the first Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data for Hong Kong (1996-2001), Head of Operations and Technology for Citicorp Asia Pacific, President of North Asia for EDS, and Department Head of the Hong Kong Government Data Processing Agency (the precursor to ITSD and OGCIO).

Active in community affairs, Mr Lau is the President of HKCS from 2010-2013 and the Vice President and Honorary Secretary of HKCS during the period of 2004-2008. As an active supporter of HKCS for over 30 years, he has held chairmanships of its Hong Kong International Computer Conference (HKICC) and Joint International Computer Conference (JICC) and coordinated HKCS' responses to Government's IT-related consultative exercises. He was also the appointed Chairman of the Provisional Governance Board of the HK Institute of IT Professional Certification.

Leonard Chan is the founder and CEO of Pulse MediaTech Limited (PMT), overseeing the strategic development and product development of the company. He has founded his first tech startup in 2000 and was listed in Hong Kong in 2002. Mrs Mak has an illustrious career with over 30 years of experience in management positions in public organisations and multi-national companies. Specialize in developing strategic plans and corporate roadmaps, designing and enforcing corporate governance as well as re-engineering business processes with a wide range of companies and industry sectors, with a focus on driving and building effective development of team members and working relationships with business partners.

Mrs Mak is also an advocate in advancing professional recognition for IT professionals in Hong Kong. She is the Chairperson of the Information & Communications Technology Industry Training Advisory Committee under the Education Bureau of HKSAR Government. Under her leadership, the Specification of Competency Standards for the IT industry was successfully developed. She was also the Director In-charge of the Hong Kong Institute for IT Professional Certification which pioneered the first IT Professional credentialing scheme in Hong Kong.

In recognition of her exemplary contribution to the IT profession in Hong Kong, Mrs Mak was presented the “Ten Most Outstanding Young Persons” award in 1995. In 1999, she was conferred Distinguished Fellow of the Hong Kong Computer Society. In 2002, she was appointed as a “Justice of Peace” . In July 2007, she was awarded “Medal of Honor” by the HKSAR Government. And in November 2008, she was conferred Honorary Fellow of Vocational Training Council.
